Pedestrians, cyclists, skateboarders and drivers must be aware of each other. It's important to follow the rules of the road, and keep each other safe!

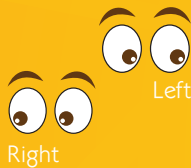
2. Remember to stop, look and listen at every driveway, road and intersection.

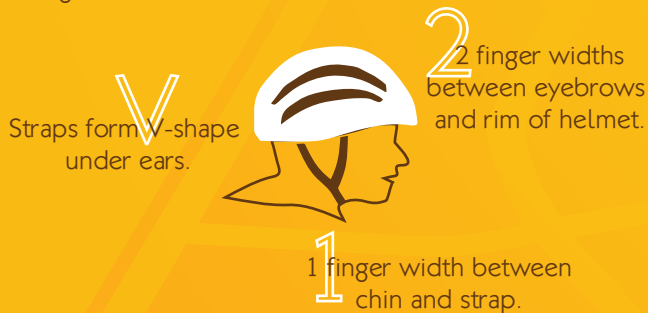

How to Use This Map

Plan your child's route to school

Choose a route together and mark it on the map. Use the symbols on the map to find sidewalks, traffic signals and safe crossing locations.

Practice traffic safety skills with your child

Go for a walk around the neighbourhood. Practice crossing the street safely together.

Choose active transportation

Walk, bike, scoot or wheel to school when you can. Organize a walking school bus with other families in your neighborhood.

Improve traffic safety and congestion

Obey parking signs and avoid 'buses only' areas. Take the school bus, or carpool. Consider parking a short distance from school and walking the rest of the way.
