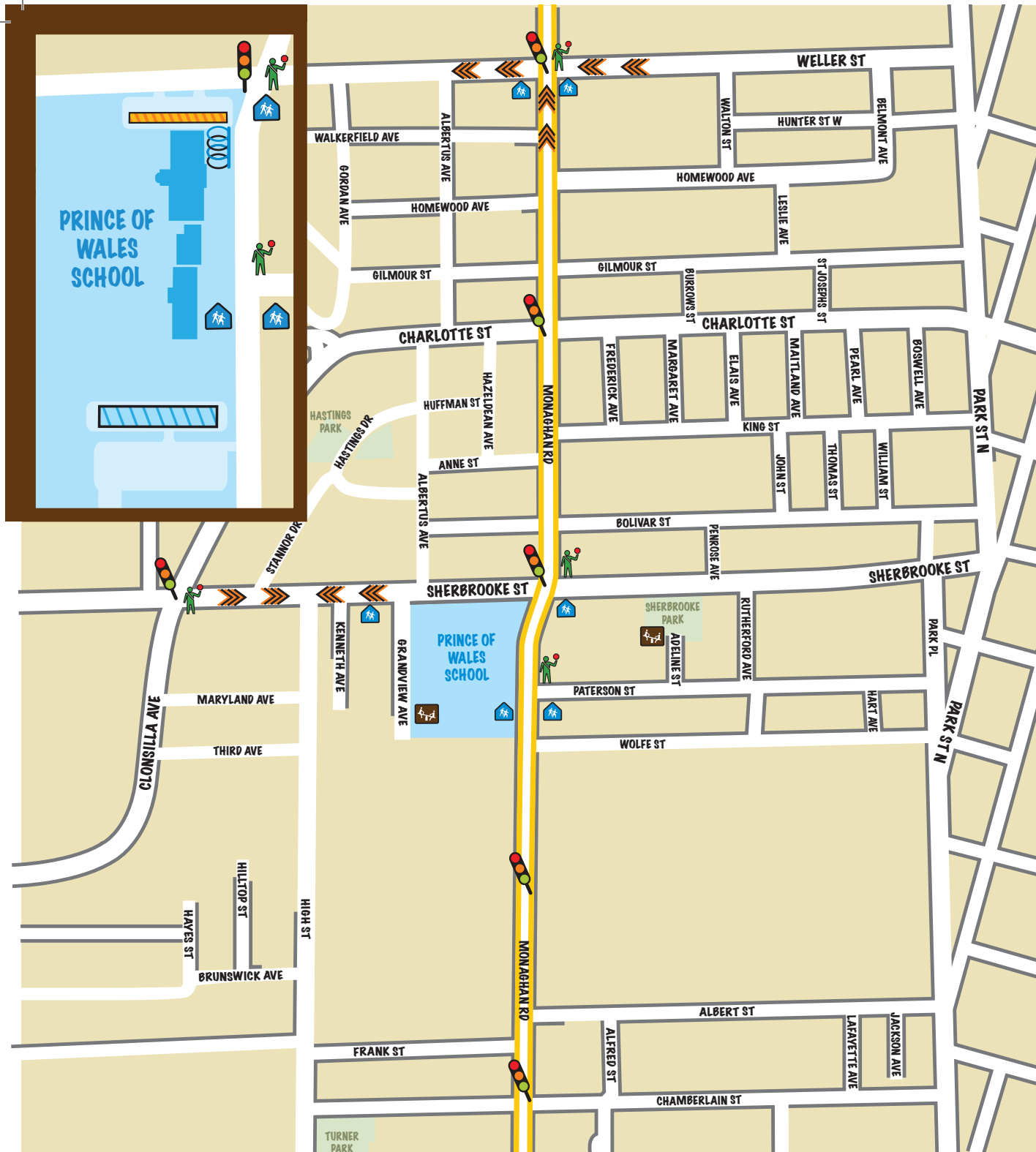
Route to School Planner

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HOW TO USE THIS MAP

Plan your child's route to school: Discuss how your child will travel to school. Choose a route together and mark it on the map.

Teach and practice traffic safety skills with your child: Go for a walk around the neighbourhood together. Use the symbols on the map to show your child walking paths, sidewalks, traffic signals and safe crossing locations. Practice crossing the street safely together.

Improve traffic safety around the school:

Traffic congestion around schools is a health and safety concern. If you are driving your child to school, obey parking signs and avoid 'buses only' lanes. When picking your child up, consider parking a short distance from the school and walking to the school to meet your child.

How does your family travel to school?

Make your trip to school safer, healthier and greener by choosing active and efficient transportation: walk, cycle, ride your school bus, ride public transit, or carpool with friends.
