TOTAL NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS, PER CHALLENGE CATEGORY



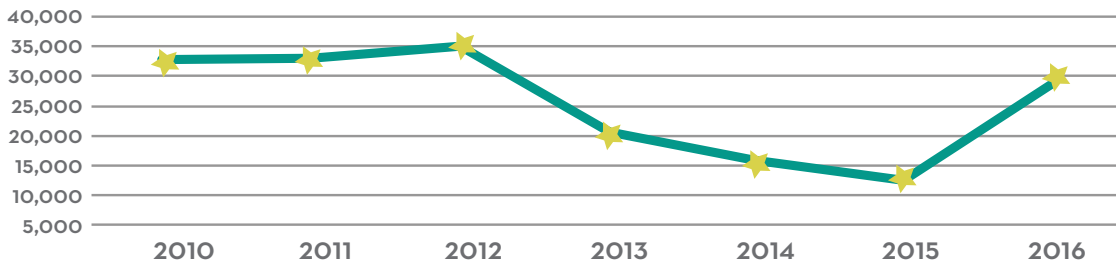
Sustainable Trips

AVERAGE NUMBER OF SUSTAINABLE TRIPS LOGGED/PARTICIPANT



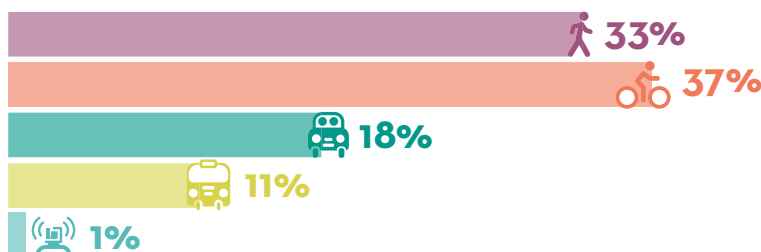
Annual Trip Rates
